

Dr. Myles N. Sheehan is Senior Associate Dean for Educational Programs at Loyola University Chicago's Stritch School of Medicine. Dr. Sheehan is a specialist in Internal Medicine and Geriatrics and has been listed as one of Chicago's Top Doctors yearly since 2001.

Dr. Sheehan was named a 1999-2001 Faculty Scholar with the Project on Death in America; his project focused on improving the care of the dying in the American Catholic community. As part of this work, Dr. Sheehan developed the *Recovering Our Traditions* program. *Recovering Our Traditions* combines materials from the EPEC (Educating Physicians on End of Life Care) curriculum with original contributions and aspects of moral and pastoral teaching relevant for Catholic healthcare settings and professionals who work in Catholic healthcare. Dr. Sheehan was a contributor to the 2001 Illinois Bishop's Pastoral *Facing the End of Life*.

Dr. Sheehan is a 1978 graduate of Dartmouth College and a 1981 graduate of Dartmouth Medical School. He trained in Internal Medicine at Boston's Beth Israel Hospital from 1981-1984 and received further training in Geriatrics from the Harvard Geriatric Fellowship Program from 1989-1991. Dr. Sheehan was an Instructor in Medicine from 1991-1995 at Harvard Medical School and attending physician and Director of Geriatric Consultation Services at Beth Israel Hospital. From 1992-1995 Dr. Sheehan was the recipient of a Brookdale Foundation Fellowship in Geriatrics. Dr. Sheehan entered the Society of Jesus (the Jesuits) in 1985 and was ordained a priest in 1994. Dr. Sheehan received an M.A. in Philosophy/Health Care Ethics in 1989 from Loyola University of Chicago and an M. Div. from Weston Jesuit School of Theology in Cambridge, Massachusetts in 1994.

Dr. Sheehan's major current professional activities include administrative, teaching, and curricular development work in his role as Senior Associate Dean. He continues a practice in geriatric medicine. He was named in 2006 the Ralph P. Leischner Professor of Medical Education and Director of the Ralph P. Leischner, Jr. Institute for Medical Education. In 2007, Dr. Sheehan received the Master Teacher Award from the faculty of the Stritch School of Medicine
