PCM-1 Clinical Skills Preceptor Program Activities

The actual content of the program should consist of all of the required activities, and may be expanded to include optional activities listed below. A minimum of two contacts per semester is required.

Required Activities

- 1. See patients in the office or hospital rounds with the Clinical Skills Preceptor (CSKiP).
- 2. Begin interviewing patient independently in semester two
- 3. TWO mandatory patient interviews to be presented at an assigned small group session in semester two (February & March 2011).

Other Optional Activities

- 1. Attend departmental meetings.
- 2. Attend professional association events with the mentor.
- 3. Observe administrative activities and aspects of office practice.
- 4. Observe office/hospital procedures.
- 5. Observe community involvement of physicians.
- 6. Spend time with physician's family.
- 7. Coffee/lunch- discussion time with physician.
