BE OBSERVANT OF PATIENT'S GENERAL APPEARANCE

1. WASH HANDS

PATIENT SEATED IN CHAIR, FEET FLAT ON FLOOR

2. Palpate radial pulses simultaneously.
3. Check blood pressure by palpation 1 arm.
4. Check blood pressure by auscultation both arms.

PATIENT SITTING ON THE EXAM TABLE, FACING THE EXAMINER

5. Inspect & palpate fingers (nails, joints) hands (palms), wrists, elbows, and ...
