


Supraspinatus/ Infraspinatus Atrophy

External Rotation


- Measure in adduction

- Restriction
 - Adhesive Capsulitis
 - Osteoarthritis




Internal Rotation

Strength Grading

- Grade 5 Normal strength
- Grade 4 Decreased resistance
- Grade 3 Resist gravity, no resistance
- Grade 2 Motion with gravity eliminated
- Grade 1 No motion, palpabable contracture
- Grade 0 No motion no contracture
