Team Peer Teaching: Evaluation and Feedback

Dissection of a single cadaver will be completed by eight students, four working as TEAM A and four working as TEAM B. Teams will alternate teaching assignments as per the schedule. Peer presentations should be clear, concise, accurate and complete. You will evaluate your peers each week during the course (see process below). Feedback sessions based on these evaluations will be scheduled three times during the course.

Evaluation process:

- You will receive an email from Lucia Garcia, SHB Course Coordinator, each week with a link to the evaluation.
- Each team will need to complete a consolidated evaluation of the peer teaching completed by the other team at your dissection table.
- The evaluation will be sent on Friday and be available through Monday for you to complete. We recommend that you select a team leader for each week to coordinate peer teaching responsibilities which would include completing and submitting the peer teaching evaluation.
- A feedback session will be scheduled with your team if the evaluation results reflect a low score or concerns are noted under the comment section. Feedback sessions will be held the week of October 26, November 16, and December 7.
- If your team is not contacted for a session, but you would still like feedback on your teaching, you may request a session by signing up on the form available in the Teaching and Learning Center.

This feedback will assist all participants to improve their approach to teaching, effective communication, and learning.
