- Comments on first write-up
 - Dr. Boyle (today) and I (Thursday) meeting this week with first randomly selected MS2 – 1 from each small group – check emails
 - If error – one line through with “error”
 - Don’t completely scratch out
 - 2nd H&P and PE
 - Ideally both a MS4 and facilitator review
 - Prefer facilitator if only one reviewer



Comments on first write-up

- If hospitalized pt, write-up as **FIRST** day in ED/hospital
 - Not 3 days later when they feel better and are going home
- Chief complaint should have duration too
 - “Worst headache of my life **FOR 2 DAYS**”



Comments on first write-ups

- Every medicine should have a diagnosis in adult illnesses
 - Look up meds you don’t know
 - Lipitor 10 mg daily
 - Lisinopril 20 mg daily
 - Metformin 500 mg daily
- As MS2s, list **ALL** the negatives in ROS
 - Don’t just write “Cardiac – negative”
 - Write – “Cardiac – no CP, no SOB, no PND, no orthopnea...”



Comments on first write-up

- If your pt was hospitalized
 - and had to leave for a test
 - or was too tired to complete history
- Write that down!
 - If possible, return later that day or next day to complete
