# SAMPLE PHYSICAL EXAMINATION CHARTING WITH ALL NORMAL FINDINGS Write Up Guidelines for Head to Toe OSCE

## **GENERAL APPEARANCE**:

45 y/o female who is awake and alert and who appears healthy and looks her stated age

## **VITALS**

Temperature: 37.5° C oral

Blood Pressure: R Arm/Palpation (Systolic) - 120

R Arm/Auscultation- 126/70 L Arm/Auscultation- 126/70

Heart Rate: 80 regular

RR: 14

**HEENT** 

Head: Normocephalic, Hair-- normal texture; Scalp- $\theta$  lesions, tenderness

Eyes: Sclera- white

Conjunctiva- pink Fundoscopy-

Red Reflex: present

Disc: round, sharp margins, nl color Vessels: nl caliber, A/V ratio ~ 2:3

Background: no abnormal pigmentation, hemorrhages or

exudates Macula: visualized

Ears: External Ear- $\theta$  lesions, masses, tenderness

Auditory Canal- normal

Eardrum- TMs gray, translucent, with nl light reflex

Nose: Color- pink  $\theta$  discharge

Septum- midline

Inferior and Middle Turbinates – normal

Throat and Teeth: present and in good dentition

Mouth: Tongue:  $\theta$  lesions

Gums and Mucosa:  $\theta$  swelling, bleeding, infection

Pharynx and Tonsillar Fossa: normal

Openings of Stensen's and Wharton's Ducts: identified

## NECK

Active ROM: nl flexion, extension, lateral rotation and tilting

Trachea: midline, mobile

Thyroid: non-palpable or palpable, nl size & consistency,  $\theta$  lesions

Suprasternal Notch:  $\theta$  pulsation

## **BREASTS**

Symmetrical upon inspection, nipples symmetrical and everted;  $\theta$  masses, nipples  $\theta$  discharge

## THORAX & BACK

<u>LUNGS</u> symmetrical expansion with respiration

nl resonant percussion

Clear, normal vesicular breath sounds in all lung fields, anteriorly and posteriorly

(may write: Clear to A&P)

#### **HEART**

Neck Veins- θ JVD at 45°

Carotid Arteries:

nl upstroke & amplitude bilaterally;  $\theta$  bruits

Precordium:

 $\theta$  lifts or heaves - PMI not visible

 $\theta$  parasternal impulses,  $\theta$  thrills

PMI- palpable in 5<sup>th</sup> ICS, MCL; nl size

Normal S1, S2;  $\theta$  S<sub>3</sub>, S<sub>4</sub>;  $\theta$  murmurs

## **ABDOMEN**

Scaphoid  $\theta$  scars, striae;

nl bowel sounds,  $\theta$  bruits;

nontender with both superficial and deep palpation;

no masses, no guarding.

Liver: liver edge not palpable

Percussion - Size- ~10 cm in R midclavicular line

Palpation- non palpable

Kidneys: Not palpable,  $\theta$  CVA tenderness

Femoral Pulses: 2+, nl and symmetric;  $\theta$  bruits

## **EXTREMITIES**

Upper: Nails- nl,  $\theta$  cyanosis, clubbing

Palms- nl color, texture

Muscles- nl size

Joints: no deformity, no redness or swelling; normal ROM,

Radial pulse 2+, nl and symmetric

Lower: Nails- nl,  $\theta$  cyanosis, clubbing

Muscles- nl size

Joints: no deformity, no redness or swelling; normal ROM,

Pulses:

Posterior Tibial 2+ bilaterally equal Dorsalis Pedis 2+ bilaterally equal

<u>SPINE</u>:  $\theta$  spine tenderness to percussion, full ROM

SKIN: nl,  $\theta$  lesions

# **LYMPH NODES**

(list only the nodes

you examine)

submental, submandibular, anterior and posterior cervical, pre and post auricular, suboccipital, supraclavicular, axillary, epitrochlear, superficial

inguinal—no lymphadenopathy

## **NEUROLOGIC**

Mental Status: awake, alert; oriented x 3

Cranial Nerves: II-XII intact

Muscle strength: 5/5 throughout both upper and lower extremities

(Note:  $\theta$  This symbol of a zero with a line crossing through it indicates the absence of a finding; this is usually seen in hand written charts. You can easily substitute the word "no" in its place.)
