

## **ASSESSMENT**

Students are required to meet with clerkship staff for two feedback sessions. The first will occur on/approximately mid-way through the clerkship. The second will occur after the completion of the final exam.

For the mid-clerkship feedback, students are asked to complete an assessment form that lists self-identified strengths and opportunities for improvement. These will be used to help guide students towards maintaining and achieving their clerkship goals.

Students are provided with a QR code for their evaluation form. Students are asked to print/provide it to each attending they are assigned to work with at the end of the shift. Faculty and students are asked to discuss real-time feedback as it relates to their clinical performance so it can be used to help improve for the next shift.

## **GRADES**

Final Grade Breakdown:

- 35% Final Exam
- 5% Clinical Leadership
- 10% osce
- 40% Clinical Grade
- 10% ACEP Quizzes

Final examination grades are typically released to students following week of the final exam. Final clerkship grades are typically submitted to the Office of Registration and Records between two to four weeks from the completion of your clerkship.

The grading curve is 30/40/30 for P/HP/H. The curve is reevaluated two times during the academic year. Students will never move down a grade but those on the border between two grades may see an increase in their final grade as the curve is calibrated.

Students not passing the final exam will be given an opportunity to remediate according to SSOM policies. Students not passing the clerkship will be given an opportunity to remediate according to SSOM policies.
