<b>Site Expectations</b>	<p>Students will have the opportunity to rotate one-on-one with a hospitalist at Gottlieb Memorial Hospital on the general medicine inpatient service. Gottlieb is a community hospital within the Loyola system and will provide the students exposure to the practice of medicine in the community setting. Students will manage their own patients under direct supervision of the hospitalist, which will include admitting, discharging and day-to-day management and decision-making. The student will have mid rotation and end rotation evaluations. Students will work with 2-4 different attendings over the four weeks who may have differing styles. This rotation is meant for students who are interested in internal medicine, family medicine, primary care, or who may be doing an internal medicine preliminary year.</p>
