| Site Expectations | <p>Team specific; varies from service to service</p> <p><u>Loyola Hospitalist service:</u> M4 students work one-on-one with a hospitalist, caring for hospitalized patients on the medicine wards and providing co-management for surgical patients' medical problems. Sub-interns will focus on managing complex patients with independent medical decision-making to provide efficient, high-value care. Learning will occur through seeing and working up patients, frequent discussions with the hospitalist attending about each patient's care, and a focused reading curriculum on core inpatient medical conditions. The students will have mid rotation and end rotation evaluations. This rotation is meant for students who are interested in internal medicine, family medicine, primary care, or who may be doing an internal medicine preliminary year.</p> |
