Parking	Parking for Residents and Students is in the 4-tier employee-parking garage. The parking garage is on the East end of the campus, marked "Garage Entrance "5". All students and residents are to park between floors 2A-4. Do not park on the ground level at any time.			
Reporting Time & Location	 On the first day of your rotation, you need to report to the Medical Education Office to 8:00am for check in and orientation. For the rest of your rotation, arrive around 7am to chart review and preround on your patient(s). Formal sign out will be at 7:30am. Parking in the parking garage, walk across to entrance 5. Once you badge in through the sliding doors, turn Left, take the next Left and there will be a door with a code on your immediate Left. Code is "214". Press the number "3" in the elevator and you will arrive in the lounge/work room. 			
Food	Cafeteria available all day for 3 meals. Starbucks open until 2pm. Entree with 2 sides around \$10, other entree and side options available for similar price plus lots of drink and snack options. Free coffee machines on the floors, Keurig in the resident lounge, fridge in the resident lounge to store your own food.

Site Expectations	Students are expected to: - Chart review and pre-round on their patient(s) at around 7am - Formal sign out from night team to day team at 7:30am at which the medical student may present their patient(s) - Teaching rounds at sign out above plus at midday rounds a few times a week - Medical students will present 1-2x per week - Group rounds at 8am at which students are to lead the encounter with regards to patient interview and updating the team and patient with plans for the day and attempt to answer patient questions to the best of their ability - Medical students will write a practice note and review with the resident assigned to the same patient as them for that day. It will be signed into the chart by the student and labeled as a practice note by said resident.
